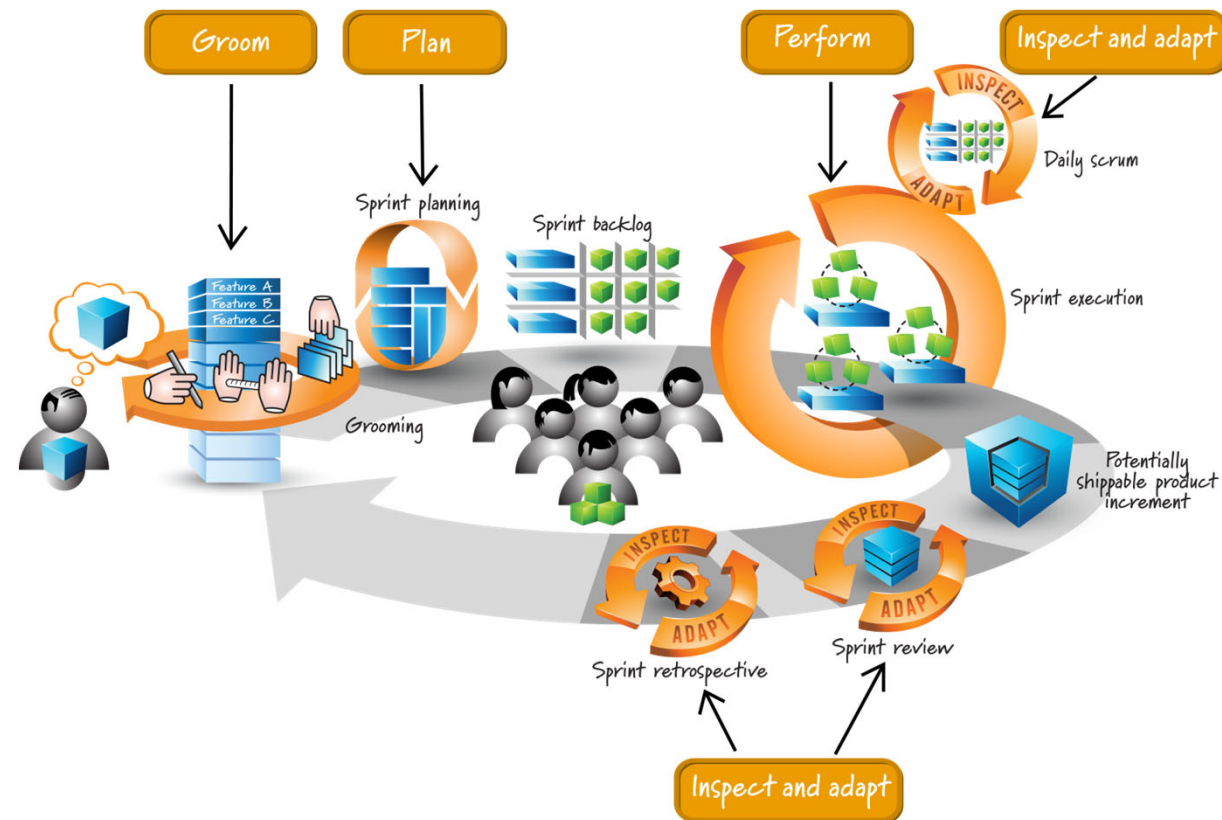


Development Team –

Professionals who do the work of delivering a potentially releasable Increment of “Done” product at the end of each Sprint

Accountability lies with team as a whole

- All decisions taken jointly as a team (shared responsibility)



Development Team –

Professionals who do the work of delivering a potentially releasable Increment of “Done” product at the end of each Sprint

- **Self-organizing.**
 - No one (not even the Scrum Master) tells the Development Team how to turn Product Backlog into Increments of potentially releasable functionality
 - ...turn Backlog items into increments
 - ...develop functionality
 - ...make it potentially releasable
- **Cross – Functional**
 - with all the skills as a team necessary to create a product Increment
 - no titles for Development Team members other than Developer
 - No sub-teams in the Development Team
- **Size: 6 ±3**
 - Fewer than three members decrease productivity
 - Smaller Teams may encounter skill constraints
 - > 9 members requires too much coordination
 - Product Owner and Scrum Master roles are not included in this count unless they are also executing the work of the Sprint Backlog
